A worldview common among indigenous religions that sees all elements of nature as being filled with spirit or spirits is animism in Hawaii the goddess of fire whose place of veneration in the volcano is.

**For the purpose of a brief description of the religion of the American Indians we define religion as a group of concepts and acts which spring from the relation of the individual to the outer world the scope of religious concepts depends to a certain extent on the knowledge of the laws of nature and since the natural and the supernatural as conceived in the mind of Native Americans does**

Many animals were considered sacred by the people of indigenous tribes of America and when animals are revered as a god or deity they hold great spiritual significance and

The origins of contemporary Native American religion and that of their recent ancestors can be traced back 30 000 to 60 000 years the religion and spirituality of Native Americans has developed from the hunting taboos animal ceremonialism beliefs in spirits and shamanism embraced by their early ancestors and passed down in oral histories. Symbolism especially with animals is often a main part of Native American religion animals were used to represent certain ideas characteristics and spirits some Native American tribes used animals to tell the story of creation some creation stories one by the Tlingit Indians were centered on a raven.

**Deities and spirits Native American religions often honor a vast array of deities some of these are creator gods others are tricksters deities of the hunt and gods and goddesses of healing the term great spirit is applied often in Native American spirituality to refer to the concept of an all encompassing power**

Although the main teachings will be from a North American Native point of view the actual practices and beliefs were mostly held in many indigenous tribal cultures throughout the world including Hawaiian Celtic South American Native Russian Shamanic cultures as well as many other societies like the Australian Aboriginal tribes. Native Americans are not the only folk with spirit animals Russians have it Celts have it and the Norse have it as well for example the Druidic religion which is a folk religion of the Irish people believed in a connection with the animal realm. Native American religions are the spiritual practices of the indigenous peoples of the Americas this article focuses on Native North Americans traditional Native American ceremonial ways can vary widely and are based on the differing histories and beliefs of individual tribes clans and bands early European

explorers describe individual native american tribes and even small bands as each having their own religious practices theology may be monotheistic polytheistic henotheistic animistic. Native american spirituality includes rituals that represent hunting and growing of earth s produce which was such a prevalent way of life for native americans history shows that native american spirituality included many ceremonies and rituals that were practiced before and even after hunting expeditions.

**Traditional native american religions exhibit a great deal of diversity largely due to the relative isolation of the different tribes that were spread out across the entire breadth of the north american continent for thousands of years allowing for the evolution of different beliefs and practices between tribes native american religion is closely connected to the land in which native**

Native americans identify their spiritual leaders by many terms such as doctor medicine person elder herbalist diagnostician or spiritwalker many tribes object to the mislabeling of these. Native americans believed that powerful beings or spirits were present in all natural things invisible but everywhere this supernatural force of the spirit world touched people animals and plants. As in many goddess religions the native american conception divides the universe into heaven earth and underworld distinctions among spirits divinities humans and animals are often blurred animals places even stones and trees can possess spirits that interact with humans in a kind of cosmic harmony similar to the ancient concept of.

**As my spiritual path has evolved i ve discovered a growing appreciation and respect for native american spiritual beliefs and traditions i know there are many differences among tribes but in general they all appear to share a reverence for the land for animals and plants for the bonds of munity for the wisdom of the elderly and for the contributions of their ancestors**

**Today animism continues in most tribal religious movements in shinto in eastern religions such as buddhism and hindusim and in pagan neopagan movements in addition to believing inanimate objects have spirits many believe in revering the spirits of ancestors who have an influence on those who are living**

It was linked to an animism which saw kindred spirits in all animals and plants the indians viewed the white man s attitude to nature as the polar opposite of the indian the white man seemed hell bent on destroying not just the indians but the whole natural order felling forests clearing land killing animals for sport. Native american spirituality beliefs of native americans from the arctic to the southwest sponsored link the inuit the traditional inuit eskimo culture is similar to those found in other circumpolar regions northern russia and the northern scandinavian countries life has been precarious there are the double challenges of the cold and the continual threat of starvation. This means native american religion is an extremely broad category the religious beliefs of modern americans and asians and europeans and africans span a wide range and so do the spiritual traditions of native americans that being said most native american religions share a set of mon features. Spirit animals is a bastardization of a collection of traditions among some native american tribes the use of spirit animal in popular culture infantilizes and patronizes a long standing.

Often referred to as religion most native americans did not consider their spirituality ceremonies and rituals as religion in the way that christians do rather their beliefs and practices form an integral and seamless part of their very being like other aboriginal peoples around the world their beliefs were heavily influenced by their methods of acquiring food from. Unitarian universalism up non theistic religions previous non theistic religions contents the great spirit the great spirit wakan tanka gitchei manitou of native american cultures is a beautiful example of a non theistic belief in an active personal non anthropomorphic deity that is intertwined with the fabric of the universe itself on the large scale and yet is personally engaged with.

**One popular textbook the american way describes native american religion in these words these native americans in the southeast believed that nature was filled with spirits each form of life such as plants and animals had a spirit earth and air held spirits too people were never alone they shared their lives with the spirits of**  
The lines of munication between spirits and native athabaskans were kept open using the shaman to translate there are still spiritual beliefs about the connection between animals and humans prevalent in the athabaskan culture the raven is the most popular animal followed by the caribou wolf and bear.

**The concept of spirit animals draws its origins from ancient animistic and totemistic beliefs about the world and our connection to it totemism a system of belief practised by the native american indian people and the australian aboriginal people for example incorporates the notion that each human being has a spiritual connection to another physical being e g a plant or animal**

The connection of people to animals of animals to nature and of all things to the great spirit considered the creator of all things the great spirit is the supreme deity of the native american indians similar to the god referred to by many western religions the great spirit is seen as the all powerful ruler of the universe. This is very much in contrast with the themes of native american culture as most native americans firmly believe in the cultivation and preservation of natural resources one way in which native american culture embraces nature is through the use of all resources typically animals that are used for food are also used for many other things.

**It should be pointed out that sometimes the use of totem animals and other native american practices is sometimes seen as cultural appropriation when it s done by non native american individuals some european shamanic systems do connect with animal spirits but the use of the specific word totem often implies a native american connection**

dying remnants of humankind s childhood these traditions lacked sacred texts and fixed doctrines or moral codes and were embedded in.
